## WORCESTER SALE 2010

The first Official Autumn British White Sale will be held at Worcester Mart on Saturday 25th September 2010. It is hoped that this will become an annual sale and is open to haltered and un-haltered cattle. This is an additional sale to the Melton Show and Sale held 2 weeks earlier.

There will not be a show for pedigree cattle, but a trophy will be presented to the vendor of the highest price lot (to be sold in guineas).

Store cattle will be sold in pounds and the usual 5% commission will apply. There will also be a £25.00 prize for both the vendor and purchaser of the best pen of steers sired by a named and registered British White Bull. The judge for this commercial prize will be Mr Paul Pennington, Bridgnorth, Shropshire.

All cattle will be inspected prior to sale and **must** be in fair condition, they do not need to be washed.

There will not be an entry fee, but a pro rata charge (per lot) will be levied to cover advertising and catalogue costs.

All stores from the same vendor will be counted as one lot.

Cattle may, by prior arrangement arrive on Friday between 3.00 and 5.00pm.
