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PREFACE

There has been no decline in the support to the Park Cattle breed during the past two years. While its numbers remain small, it has nevertheless maintained its position.

HERD BOOK REGISTRATIONS. The entries number 22 bulls and 119 cows. This compares favourably with the entries for the previous volume, when there were 17 bulls and 114 cows.

TRANSFERS. An increase was shown in the number of these, 5 bulls and 15 cows having changed ownership since the last issue of the Herd Book, compared with 6 bulls and 10 cows in Volume 12.

MILK RECORDS. No one need doubt the milk producing capabilities of the breed, as in the polled section the Bawdeswell herd can boast of no less than 11 cows with records of well over 8,000 lbs. with individual records as follows for the year ending Oct., 1942.

COLONEL SIR WALTER SHAKERLEY, BART., C.B.E.

AND

THE INFLUENCE OF THE SOMERFORD HERD ON BOTH THE
HORNED AND THE POLLED HERDS.

The older Members of the Society will have heard with great regret of the death of Sir Walter Shakerley. Although few of us saw very much of him, he and Lady Shakerley were original Members and very useful ones, for visitors could be sure of a most hospitable welcome to Somerford, and when financial help was needed they were always most generous subscribers: too much so I fear in the light of later knowledge of the misfortunes which caused their magnificent Georgian house to be pulled down and their cattle dispersed. Sir Walter succeeded to the property in 1898, and the sale of the cattle took place in Oct., 1925. The Somerford Herd has probably had more influence than any other on the Park Cattle of to-day, being both geographically and in type intermediate between the horned herds and the polled ones. The Shakerley family originated at a place of the same name close to Middleton, from which came all the polled herds in the Eastern Counties, and it has been assumed that those at Somerford had the same origin, but Somerford is only 15 miles from Lyme and 30 from Chartley, and Storer was so struck by the likeness between the Somerfords and the Chartleys that he wrote: "I think that if the Chartley horns could be added to the Somerfords, or the Chartleys become polled, small indeed would be the differences of appearance between the two."*

Had he lived to our days, he would have had full confirmation of his surmise, for when I mated Somerford horned cows with the Chartley bull Brace 13, almost all the progeny were the image of their sire, horns and all.

Mr. Masefield discovered that the Ferrers family crossed the Chartleys with cattle from their property in Wales, and here probably came a connection between the Lamphey and Dynevor cattle with those at Lyme, Chartley and Somerford, and through the last named with the polled Middletons, who were of the same stock as the other polled herds in the North of England and probably those of the lowlands of Scotland and possibly at Cadzow where the cattle were originally polled but afterwards acquired horns, perhaps through the Chillinghams since, these herds are situated at opposite ends of the great Caledonian forest.

And now let us see what the early volumes of our Herd Book tell us of the influence of Somerford. The earliest reference is in the Woodbastwick herd to a bull called Sir Charles, who was obtained by R. E. Lofft of Stanton in 1882 from Sir Charles Shakerley and passed on in 1889 to Woodbastwick. Another Somerford bull called Northumberland sired Woodbastwick Cumberland 1st who was in his turn responsible for a very large number of entries. At the same period another Somerford bull, Blickling Taurus, was in command at Blickling, and at Northrepps the reigning bull was a descendant of Sir Charles, while at Bawdeswell great use was being made of Bawdeswell Somers, bred at Somerford, who has some 20 entries, including Faygate Dairyman, the founder of the polled section of my herd. As all the polled herds have regularly obtained changes of blood from these it is not necessary to say more.

In the horned herds, although the Somerford influence has been limited to rather fewer individuals, it is equally evident. The first person to appreciate its value was that very astute breeder, Mr. George Dawkins, who in pre-Herd Book days had already been using a Somerford bull and a cow to improve his large horned herd which were mainly of Welsh origin. To found my herd I arranged to take all the horned cows that could be spared from Somerford and in due course received a number of them. Mr. Dawkins took a bull calf

out of one of them, which he called Wallflower and used a great deal, and this blood runs through most of the horned cattle to-day, including those at Dynevor and Woburn.

In fact anyone who takes the trouble to look up the pedigrees in the Herd Book will quickly discover that it is much more difficult to find any without Somerford blood than with it, so that if Somerford died under its own name; it has risen Phoenix-like in all our herds.
