## PREFACE

---

Although the breed has not increased numerically since our last volume, it has nevertheless retained its place as a dairy breed.

The Bawdeswell herd can boast of a herd average for 43 cows of 7,716 lbs., with individual records as follows: Bawdeswell Cinnamon, 13,355 lbs. for the year ending October 1st, 1945; Bawdeswell Nicotine, 10,477 lbs. for the same year, 214 other cows with records of nearer 9,000 lbs. than 8,000 lbs. Bawdeswell Cloudlet, transferred to the Faygate herd, has yielded 9,244½ lbs. in her second lactation.
